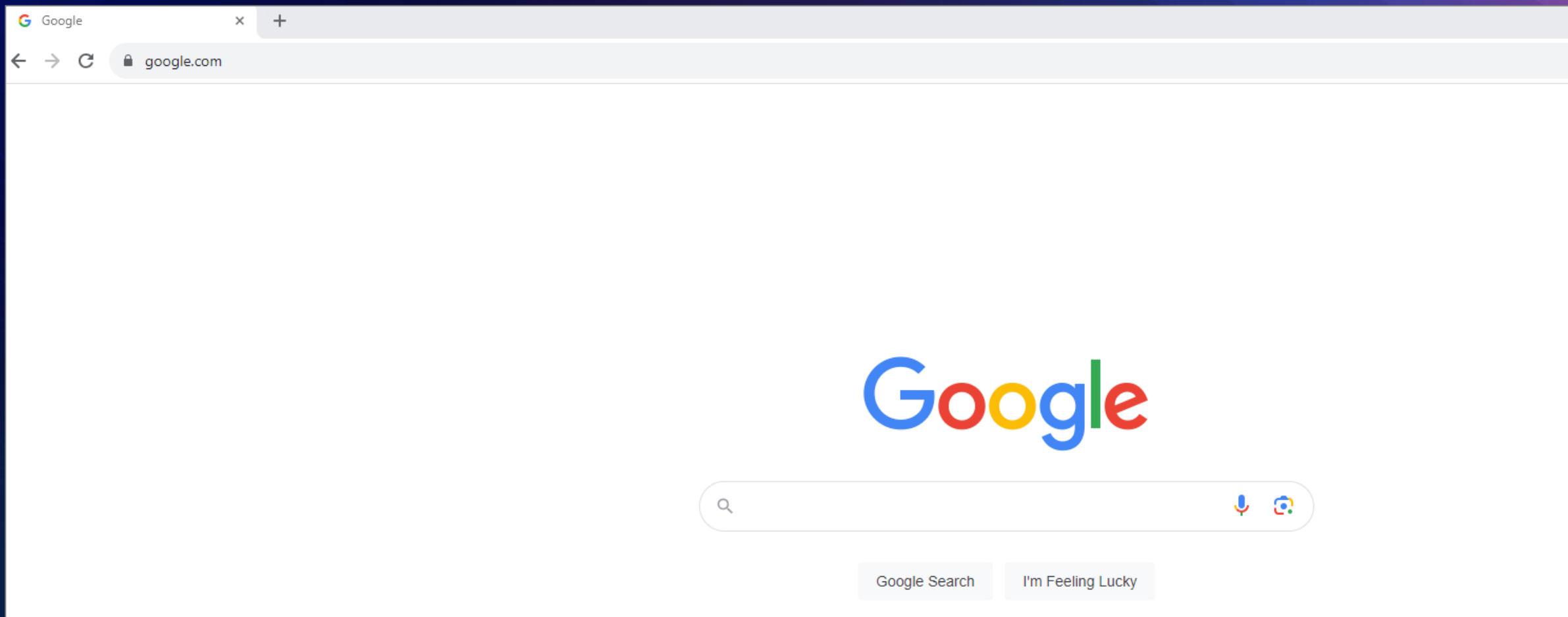




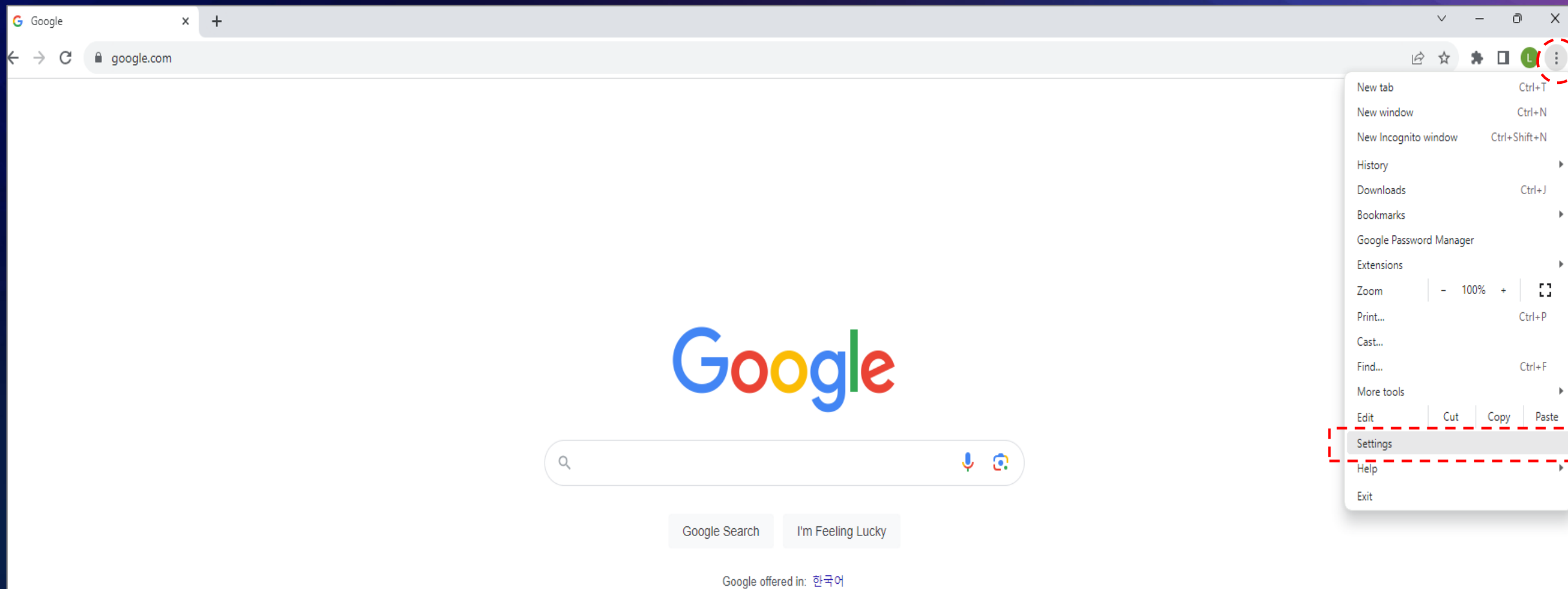
How to Use Google Translate on your Chrome Browser
